CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- This tournament is sanctioned and governed by the rules of Tennis Ireland and the Tennis Ireland Complaint, Objection and Disciplinary Rules and Procedures will be strictly enforced.
- Eight events will be held, both Mens and Ladies Team Doubles, in four categories- Grade 1-2, Grade 3 Grade 4 and Grade 5-6. Each pair will play both pairs of the opposing team. Matches will consist of two tie-break sets with a Champions Tie-break to be played in the event of each team winning a set.
- Entries close at 7pm on Tuesday 25th October 2011. Competitors may only enter one event. One entry form per team is required, but all players and their details must be provided. Individual entries will be accepted with a view to participating as part of a composite team; the Committee will endeavour to facilitate such entries by forming teams of appropriately graded players to the best of its ability.
- Junior players may enter Grade 1-2 only.
- Entry Fees- €20 per person (incl. Tennis Ireland capitation fee).
- Unavailability not listed on the Entry form cannot be accommodated. Emailed entries will be acknowledged by the club.
- Limerick-based competitors may be required to play on the evening of Friday 28th October from 7.30 pm. All players must be available for play from 9 am on Saturday 29th October.
- All Finals will take place on Monday 31st October 2011 as will a Plate event for non-finalists
- It is the competitors' responsibility to establish their time of play each day. Teams not ready to play 15 minutes after their match has been called may be scratched.
- Draw for all events will take place in the Clubhouse on Wednesday October 26th at 9pm and will be published on www.lltc.ie. and in the Clubhouse. The order of play will be posted in the Clubhouse and on www.lltc.ie.
- Teams will be entered in the event pertaining to the highest-graded player on the team irrespective of the number of team members of a lower grade.
- The schedule of play must be strictly adhered to.
- Competitors must report to the Tournament Referee on arrival each day. Entry fees must be paid before commencement of the first match.
- 12 synthetic courts will be used for the tournament.
- Tretorn Micro X balls will be used.
- Recognised tennis clothing must be worn.
- Grading will be at the discretion of the Tournament Committee in the event of a grade not being provided. The Committee reserves the right to grade events and players.
- The Committee reserves the right to restrict the number of entries in any event and to cancel or combine events where in its opinion the number of entries is inadequate.
- The Tournament Committee or Limerick Lawn Tennis Club shall not be held responsible for any injury or accident on or off the court to any player or guest or for any property damaged, destroyed, lost or stolen.
- The Referee's decision is final on all matters relating to the tournament.
